

# **PROGRAMS & SERVICES**

#### **Homeless Prevention**

**Our Homeless Prevention Program provides** Emergency Assistance and short-term case management to households at risk of eviction or foreclosure as well as to households at risk of utility shut-offs.



#### Supportive Housing

Our Supportive Housing Programs provide **Emergency Assistance and ongoing** supportive, home-based case management services to help ensure housing stability and long-term self-sufficiency.

#### **Emergency Shelter**

**Our Family Emergency Shelter provides** assistance to families experiencing literal homelessness. While in our Emergency Shelter. families work towards selfsufficiency and securing permanent housing.

### Severe Weather Activation Program

Our Severe Weather Activation Program (SWAP) provides motel vouchers to those experiencing literal homelessness during periods of inclement weather.



#### Street Outreach

**Our Homeless Street Outreach Program** provides engagement and case management to connect people experiencing unsheltered homelessness to housing, shelter, and other critical services.

#### **Respite Housing**

Our Respite Housing Program provides quick diversion services for situational homelessness which includes motel vouchers for a 2-week stay (flexible length for households fleeing domestic violence).

#### **Housing Navigation Center (HNC)**

Our Housing Navigation Center provides assistance to walk-in participants experiencing housing instability with on-site resource navigation, referrals to our programs and partner organizations, and resources including access to computers, printing, mail services and food and hygiene kits.





Whether you are a long-time supporter or just learning about who we are, we as caring members of our community, can work together to prevent and confront homelessness. Almost Home, Inc. offers programs and services to help those experiencing housing instability in Adams County, southern Weld County and just this year we expanded into Broomfield County.

Did you know according to the 2023 Point in Time Count that:

- 948 individuals are experiencing homelessness in Adams County (doubled from 462 in 2022)
- 503 of those individuals are experiencing homelessness for the first time.
- 125 of those individuals are fleeing domestic violence.
- 312 of those individuals are experiencing mental health concerns.

The increase in numbers is staggering but our organization is committed to helping our most vulnerable neighbors, but we can't do this alone, an effort of this magnitude takes a village.

I support Almost Home because they are incredibly effective at exiting people from homelessness. In the last year, Almost Home has helped more than 1,300 people gain stable housing. Almost Home is almost single-handedly ending homelessness in our region. ~ Anonymous Donor
